How we will know we're on track:

- There will be "no lives lost" between the flags.
- Patrolling membership increases year on year.
- The gender balance with patrols improves year on year.
- All patrol teams have members plus one with requisite awards.
- All patrol teams mentor members in attaining requisite awards.
- The education team is closely connected to patrol teams to complement formal training.
- Our members contribute more broadly to Surf Life Saving operations.
- Our members are participating in formal and informal surf sports activities.

- We will focus on improving the retention rate for nippers moving into seniors.
- We are identifying potential leaders early, providing opportunities for development and mentoring.
- We will look for ways to build self-esteem and resilience.
- Senior members are invited to share their experiences at events such as SRC lunch.
- We pursue ways to reinforce a "one club" culture, including common uniform and weekends away.
- Our education team is delivering programs that support the development of life savers.
- We are recognising and celebrating the diverse achievements of our people in surf life saving and the broader community.

- Our brand is protected, valued and recognised.
- We meet our commitments to partners and sponsors.
- We hold club social events, such as John Hughes Shield, to provide opportunities for members to mix socially.
- We have established a long-term lease with Sutherland Council.
- We work positively with our tenants to support their long-term stability.
- Our financial results meet or exceed budget projections.
- We know our risks and have effective controls in place.
- Our business and strategic plans are aligned with branch, state and national plans.
- We encourage volunteers to balance their commitment levels with other aspects of their lives.
